COVID-19 continues to spread across the country and world, it's likely your employees at farm or feed mill have questions about the virus. Fortunately, our team has, put together a fact sheet that can help everyone understand the virus and what they can do to help prevent it on the farm.

The following tips for staying healthy:

- Avoid close contact with sick people, both on and outside of your farm/feed mill.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth if your hands have not been washed.
- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds from your elbows to nail tips. If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Wash your hands before you eat after working or other areas of your consider area.
- Ask the employer/farm manager or owner to keep the washrooms stocked with disinfectants and soap.
- When you get home after working, always take a shower and wash your work clothes.
- Keep the bathrooms and kitchen area in your workplace/home clean and disinfected.
 - Remember that a few of the best ways to prevent the virus are thorough handwashing and proper etiquette when sneezing or coughing. Additionally,
